Key skills

We will then record the children performing the rhymes and they will be put onto Tapestry. Artist focus

Maths

This week we are focusing on number 4 and next week it will be number 5. We will be looking at ways of representing the numbers and also which numbers they are made up of. In the last week of term we will be thinking about 1 more and 1 less. You can help your child at home by asking them to make sets of 4 and 5 and by thinking about how the numbers are made up. E.g. $2+2=4$.
