

Fishing Folk


This fantastic art work showing local fishermen was created by Colin Seal. It is located outside the museum and forms part of the Sheringham Art Trail.

Sheringham's population in 1801 was 392, & was mainly fishing families such as the Wests & Peggs. It was common for fathers & sons to share the same names.

To have their own identity, they used nicknames like 'Teapot', 'Bouncer'& 'Joyful'.

Many fishermen were also on the **lifeboat crew** for Sheringham, risking their lives in all weathers to save others.

This shows the Burlington.






The railway first arrived in Sheringham in 1897. By 1907 you could be in London within 3 hours. Lots of visitors came to Sheringham because it was by the sea.

Can you spot different ways that Sheringham town centre has changed over time?
















The railway and coach companies designed colourful posters to make people want to visit Sheringham.
