English

In English, this half term we are focusing on the book Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief. This book links with the work in History on the Ancient Greek. The children have a chance to work on their summarising skills, and complete unit with a non-chronological report about a Greek God.

Maths

In Maths this term we are looking at multiplication and division methods.

In the second part of the half term, we will be moving onto fractions, this work will carry over into the second half term too.

Science

In Science this term the focus will be on Changes and properties of Materials. The children will explore many different types of materials, both natural and manufactured. The children will learn about scientific changes that are reversible or irreversible.

Foundation subjects

In History we are learning about Ancient Greece.

In Art we are looking at how the ancient Greeks entertained themselves with theatre and creating theatrical masks.

In RE the children are learning about what it means to believe in God for many different religions.

In PSHE the children are learning about how people can help others in an emergency situation.

Homework.

We expect the children to complete at least half an hour of 'Maths Whizz' practice each week gaining at least 3 progressions. Homework will continue to be on Google Classroom and we have been very impressed with the quality of work produced.
