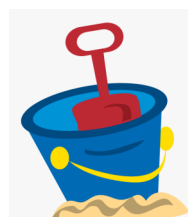
We were incredibly proud of all of the children, who performed with confidence and joy, making it a very special evening for all those who were there. We look forward to doing it all again next summer.
