Welcome

It has lovely to be able to welcome all of the children back to school and into Year 3. They are settling into their new classes and beginning to earn their Key Stage 2 merits.

At Home...

Homework: Your child will bring home their homework book each week on a Friday to be returned by the following Wednesday. This will contain various subjects and will be linked to their learning in class. This could be pre-learning for something we are about to start, or retrieval for something we have already studied.

Maths Whizz: Children must complete 30 minutes each week at home, gaining at least 1 progression.

Reading: In Year 3, we are incredibly passionate about reading! Each child will have a reading book once we have completed our reading assessments. It is important to read regularly, so that they can continue to build on their skills as a reader. To get their weekly merit sticker, the reading record book must be signed, by an adult, at least, three times a week. To achieve Reading Champion, the children must read 5 times per week.

Finally, just as a reminder, it is the child's responsibility to ensure any letters etc. in their book bags are handed in to their teacher.

Our Lessons...

In **English** we will study a variety of texts, the first term includes 'The First Drawing' by Mordicai Gernstein, 'Leon and the Place Between' by Angela McAllister 'Our Tower' by Joseph Coelho and 'Sparky!' By Jenny Offill. In **Maths** this term we will look at Number and Place Value for Autumn 1, followed by Addition and Subtraction in Autumn 2. **History, Science and Art** combines our learning of The Stone Age by learning all about rocks and fossils whilst studying how the people throughout this period of time lived. In Autumn 2 we will begin a **Geography** unit all about Natural Disasters, this will tie in with our **Guided Reading** book 'Earth Shattering Events' by Robin Jacobs. Our first unit of **RE** is all about The Holy Trinity, whilst **PSHE** we cover feelings and emotions.
