**Homework**: We will be commencing our new Homework routine in the coming weeks. We will expect the children to complete at least 30 minutes of Maths Whizz per week as well as reading every day. **Maths Whizz:** Our Homework Policy states that all children complete 30 minutes each week at home and achieve at least one progression.

**Reading:** The children are expected to read every day and bring in their Read Write Inc. wallets to have their books changed **every Wednesday**.
